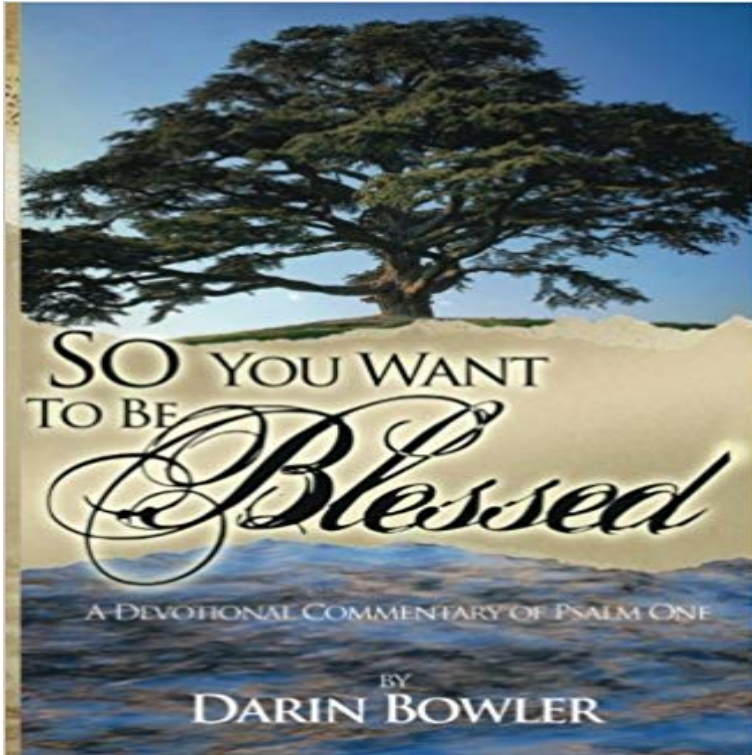


So You Want to Be Blessed: A Devotional Commentary of Psalm One

But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper. The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away. Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. For the Lord knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish. (Psalm 1). While Psalm 1 is a very brief passage of Scripture it still remains one of the richest sources of reassurance and hope during the uncertain and troubling times of life. This book offers some timeless truths to promote a healthier spiritual, inner well-being. The book draws from the four habits of the blessed man listed in Psalm 1. It reveals how life-changing these habits can be if one chooses to seriously live by them.
